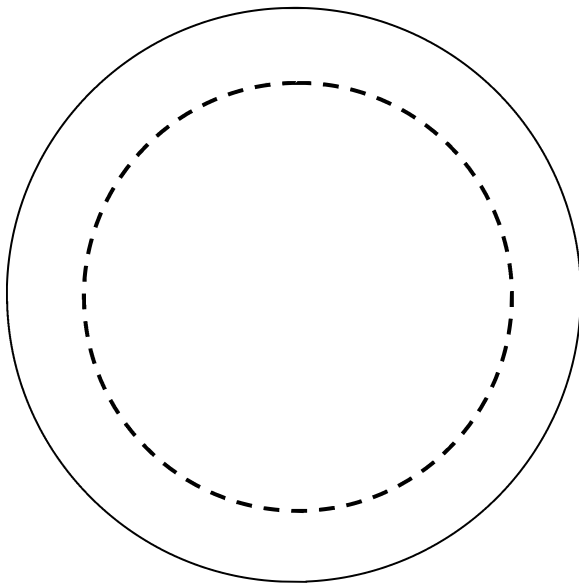
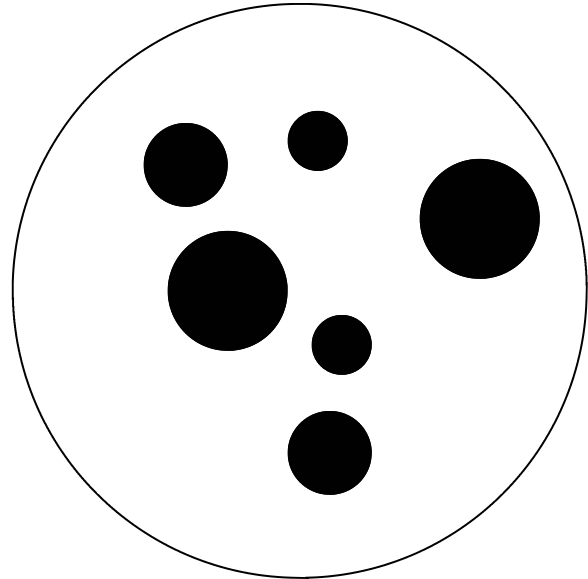


## Stuffed Mushroom Pincushion Template

- cut one for mushroom top (pattern)
- cut one for mushroom belly (linen)
- cut one for mushroom stem (linen)

You'll also need: Stuffing, sewing thread, and small pebble



### To Do:

1. Cut out all pieces. Sandwich mushroom top and belly wrong sides together. Pin. Sew around edge using zig zag (machine) or blanket stitch (hand). Leave a 1/2" hole for stuffing.
2. Trim off any excess fabric and gently stuff cap. Slipstitch closed.
3. Sew a running stitch around the outer edge of last fabric circle, about 1/2-3/4" from edge leaving 2-3" thread tail ends for gathering. Gently pull on thread to tighten fabric around pebble. Trim ends of fabric.
4. Place pebble on underside of cap and whipstitch to attach. Depending on pebble size and shape, your mushroom may tilt or lean—it's okay! It gives it personality. Add some pins and ta-da, you just grew a mushroom!
